Why should I do this course?

Gaining this qualification will enable participants to prove to employers or potential employers that they know how to handle hazardous substances and act in a safe and responsible manner in the workplace.

What's covered?

- the law relating to hazardous substances in the workplace
- how risk assessments contribute to the safe use of hazardous substances in the workplace
- the precautions and procedures necessary to ensure that risks associated with hazardous substances are properly controlled

How will my work be assessed?

This course is assessed by a 30 minute, 15 question multiple choice examination. Learners must achieve a mark of at least nine in order to pass.

What can I do after this?

On successful completion of course learners can progress onto other health & safety courses such as risk assessment and the level 2 Award in Health & Safety in the Workplace.
