What's covered?

- characteristics and consequences of food allergies and intolerances
- procedures for identifying and controlling contamination from allergenic ingredients
- procedures for the accurate communication of allergen information to consumers
- common symptoms of allergic reactions and food intolerances

How will my work be assessed?

A 15 question multiple choice examination. Learners are required to achieve a mark of at least 9 to pass.

On successful completion of course learners could progress onto a range of Food Safety qualifications offered at South Essex College. Learners will also be able to work safely with food in the retail or hospitality industry.
