#### Why should I do this course?

Gaining this qualification will enable participants to prove to employers or potential employers that they know how to act in a safe and responsible manner in the workplace.

#### What's covered?

- employer's and employee's duties relating to health, safety and welfare at work
- hazards – how to identify and with them; risk assessments and correct procedures for dealing with risk
- dealing with emergencies and the importance of record keeping
