ON-PROGRAMME PHASE: Month 01-24

INDUCTION: First 6 weeks

ON-PROGRAMME: Month 01 - 24

- Weekly day release of off-the-job Training – Delivery and achievement of Level 3 Diploma in Site Carpentry
- 4-6 weekly work-based assessment visits for the delivery and completion of Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Wood Occupations - Site Carpentry
- Delivery and achievement of Functional Skills English and maths at the required level (Classroom-based on day-release day)
